God is the only one who is able to deal with sin. The skins that God gave Adam and Eve to clothe them represent the righteousness of Christ, and that righteousness is only made possible through His perfect life and substitutionary death. By faith, the hopeless sinner becomes an heir.



## The TWO LAWS

10) Who wrote the ceremonial law, and where was it placed (Deuteronomy 31:24-26)? (00:17:20)
Remember that the moral law, the Ten Commandments, was written on stone by the finger of God, and placed inside the Ark of the Covenant. Moses wrote the ceremonial law in a book and placed it beside the Ark. These are two distinct laws.
11) When did the Ten Commandments come into existence? Did the law only arise at Mt. Sinai with Moses (Genesis 4:7, 26:5)? (00:24:00)
If sin is the transgression of the law (1 John 3:4), then there must have been a law since the birth of humanity, for Adam and Eve sinned, as did their sons.


