





Both time periods mentioned are of the same length. They symbolize the same period. Here are other instances of that same time period mentioned in Scripture: Daniel 7:25 given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time Daniel 12:7 it shall be for a time, times and a half **Revelation 12:6** the woman fled into the wilderness...that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days Revelation 12:14 that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time **Revelation 13:5** power was given unto him to continue forty and two months and half a time times A time (RSV "two times") (1 Jewish year) 180 days = 1260 prophetic days 360 days 720 days 12 months 24 months 6 months = 42 prophetic months

But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. 11) What does a woman represent in Scripture? This woman's identity was only revealed for a time before the lid was put back on the ephah and the woman was again covered up. During the Reformation the identity of the Antichrist was common knowledge. Everyone from Martin Luther to John Wesley preached it, but today the no one looks to see the truth.

Prophecy and **FRANCE**

15) Why does Revelation 11:8 refer to Egypt and Sodom? What is the spiritual significance of these places, and what are they representing in this verse? (00:32:00)



"The great city" in whose streets the witnesses are slain, and where their dead bodies lie, is "spiritually" Egypt. Of all nations presented in Bible history, Egypt most boldly denied the existence of the living God and resisted His commands. No monarch ever ventured upon more open and highhanded rebellion against the authority of Heaven than did the king of Egypt. When the message was brought him by Moses, in the name of the Lord, Pharaoh proudly answered: "Who is Jehovah, that I should hearken unto His voice to let Israel go? I know not Jehovah, and moreover I will not let Israel go." Exodus 5:2, A.R.V. This is atheism, and the nation represented by Egypt would give voice to a similar denial of the claims of the living God and would manifest a like spirit of unbelief and defiance. "The great city" is also compared, "spiritually," to Sodom. The corruption of Sodom in breaking the law of God was especially manifested in licentiousness. (Ellen White, The Great Controversy 269.2).

According to the words of the prophet, then, a little before the year 1798 some power of satanic origin and character would rise to make war upon the Bible. And in the land where the testimony of God's two witnesses should thus be silenced, there would be manifest the atheism of the Pharaoh and the licentiousness of Sodom (Ellen White, The Great Controversy 269.3).

See also this quote from The Great Controversy: "Where also our Lord was crucified." This specification of the prophecy was also fulfilled by France. In no land had the spirit of enmity against Christ been more strikingly displayed. In no country had the truth encountered more bitter and cruel opposition. In the persecution which France had visited upon the confessors of the gospel, she had crucified Christ in the person of His disciples (Ellen White, The Great Controversy 271.1).

The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

The Word of God was destroyed literally through the burning of books, but also figuratively by a new doctrine they called "Liberty." The French Revolution was the induction of the Goddess of Reason, or Liberty, to replace the God of the Bible. Here's an account of the event:

When the goddess was brought into the Convention, the orator took her by the hand, and turning to the assembly said: "Mortals, cease to tremble before the powerless thunders of a God whom your fears have created. Henceforth acknowledge no divinity but Reason. I offer you its noblest and purest image; if you must have idols, sacrifice only to such as this. . . . Fall before the august Senate of Freedom, oh! Veil of Reason!"

"The goddess, after being embraced by the president, was mounted on a magnificent car, and conducted, amid an immense crowd, to the cathedral of Notre Dame, to take the place of the Deity. There she was elevated on the high altar, and received the adoration of all present" (Ellen White, The Great Controversy, 276.1-276.2).


